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Abstract

Background - Taxpayers who are busy and have little understanding of taxation will be burdened with fulfilling their tax obligation. The population in this study were final semester students majoring in accounting at private universities. The sampling method used was purposive sampling with a sample size of 98 respondents. The data analysis method used is multiple linear regression analysis.
